

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Conference Report 4th Middlesex District Investments

4th Middlesex Community Funding - \$2.7M

- **\$350K** for **Lexington public schools** for electric school buses and charging infrastructure.
- **\$300K** for the **Burlington and Woburn public school systems** to develop a pilot program, in partnership with local primary care practices, to deliver primary care health services to low-income children enrolled in public schools.
- **\$250K** for **Arlington** for construction, upgrades, and improvements to its parks and recreational facilities.
- **\$200K** for **Arlington** for construction, upgrades and improvements to Mill brook.
- **\$200K** for **Arlington** for the acquisition of affordable housing.
- **\$200K** for **Lexington** for a feasibility and initial design study for the construction of affordable housing units in the town center.
- **\$150K** for the **Burlington Area Chamber of Commerce** to support programming and membership for local businesses.
- **\$150K** for the **Lexington Historical Society** for remodeling the historic Lexington depot community building.
- **\$125K** for **Woburn** for the installation of accessible and inclusive equipment at public playgrounds.
- **\$125K** for **Woburn** to support the economic recovery efforts of local small businesses.
- **\$110K** for historic preservation enhancements for the Howe School renovation project in **Billerica**.
- **\$100K** for **Burlington** for the creation of a pocket park in the town center.
- **\$100K** for **People Helping People, Inc.** for the maintenance of a food pantry in **Burlington**.
- **\$100K** for air quality improvements to the **Burlington Fire Department** headquarters.
- **\$100K** for the **Arlington Housing Authority** for their housing domestic violence initiative.
- **\$90K** for **Billerica** for the renovation of the town hall auditorium.
- **\$50K** for the **Billerica Historical Society** for capital improvements for historic sites located in Billerica.
